C. Station 40 Training Prop Construction Update

Assistant Chief Cole summarized the Staff Report and announced that the Coastal Commission denied the last appeal and we are back on track to move forward. He informed the Board of the process of going out for bid to construct the tower. The RFPs will come back to the Board for approval.
