ORDINANCE NO. 2024-01

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE COASTSIDE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT AMENDING THE DISTRICT FEE SCHEDULE TO INCREASE, MODIFY, AND ESTABLISH FEES FOR THE COASTSIDE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

THE COASTSIDE FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT BOARD OF DIRECTORS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN, as follows:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 13916, the Coastside Fire Protection District ("District") is authorized to adopt reasonable fees to cover the cost of any service which the District provides, or the cost of enforcing any regulation for which the fee is charged; and

WHEREAS, the District adopted a rate and fee schedule in 2000 and that schedule has been amended several times since its adoption; and

WHERAS, over the last decade, certain fees have been altered through amendments to the rate and fee schedule, but the District has not completed a comprehensive review and update to its rates and fees; and

WHEREAS, in October and November of 2023, the Board reviewed a comprehensive fee study and thereafter approved a Cost Recovery and Fee Schedule Policy dated November 15, 2023, calling for Eighty Percent (80%) cost recovery for services provided by the District; and

WHEREAS, in order to achieve Eighty Percent (80%) cost recovery, the District's fee schedule should be now be amended and should thereafter be adjusted annually to reflect increases in the Consumer Price Index for San Francisco, San Mateo and Redwood City, and a comprehensive fee study should be conducted every five (5) to seven (7) years to determine whether fees should be updated further to reflect the true cost of providing services; and

WHEREAS, notice of the proposed increases in order to bring fees into compliance with the Eighty Percent (80%) cost recovery called for by the Cost Recovery and Fee Schedule Policy has been published in a newspaper of general circulation in the District and the Board has provided an opportunity to the public to comment on the proposals at a public hearing held in conjunction with a regular meeting of the Board; and

WHEREAS, after investigation, discussion, and consideration of the comments received at the public meeting, the Board finds the rates hereinafter set forth to be reasonable and required for the proper operation of the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board further finds that the amounts of the fees hereinafter set forth comply with the Eighty Percent (80%) cost recovery called for in the Cost Recovery and Fee Schedule Policy; and

WHEREAS, the Board further finds that the increases in fees affected by this Ordinance are exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act, pursuant to Section 21080(b)(8) of

the Public Resources Code, because they are for the purposes of (1) meeting operating expenses, (2) purchasing or leasing supplies, equipment, and materials, (3) meeting financial reserve requirements, and (4) obtaining funds for capital projects necessary to maintain service within existing service areas.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Coastside Fire Protection District does hereby find, declare, order, and ordain as follows:

Section 1. All previous Ordinances and Amendments thereto adopting the District's Rate and Fee Schedule are hereby repealed and the District hereby adopts the Coastside Fire Protection District Fee Schedule as set forth in Exhibit A to this Ordinance.

Section 2. <u>Severability.</u> If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board of Directors of the Coastside Fire Protection District hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance irrespective of the fact that any one or more section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion be declared invalid or unconstitutional or ineffective.

Section 3. Pursuant to Section 13861 of the Health & Safety Code and Section 25123 of the Government Code of the State of California, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect thirty (30) days after its final passage.

Section 4. Within fifteen (15) days after the adoption of this Ordinance, the Board Secretary shall have it posted in three (3) public places designated by the Board of Directors.

This Ordinance was introduced and read on the 28th day of February, 2024, and passed and adopted on the 27th day of March 2024.
