

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 5
OF THE HALF MOON BAY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT
AND AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF OF THE COUNTY OF SAN
MATEO AND THE POLICE CHIEF OF THE CITY OF HALF MOON
BAY TO ACT AS AGENTS OF THE FIRE CHIEF AND TO ISSUE
CITATIONS FOR VIOLATIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 5

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the Half Moon Bay
Fire Protection District as follows:

Section No. 1 of the Fire Prevention Code of the Half Moon Bay
Fire Protection District, Ordinance No. 5, is hereby amended by adding
the following:

Section 10.301(h)(1). Pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section
13872, the Sheriff of the County of San Mateo and the Police Chief of
the City of Half Moon Bay are hereby named and deemed the duly autho-
rized agents of the Fire Chief of the Half Moon Bay Fire Protection
District for the purpose of issuing, and they are hereby authorized to
issue, citations for violations of Section 10.301 in the same manner as
a county, city, or city and county as authorized by Chapter 5b (commen-
cing with Section 853.1, Title II, of the California Penal Code.

Section No. 2. Publication. This ordinance shall be published once
within fifteen (15) days after its passage in the Half Moon Bay Review, a
newspaper of general circulation in the Half Moon Bay Fire Protection
District, and shall become effective thirty (30) days after the date of
its adoption.


